Right of appeal: If you are dissatisfied with the decision of Council, section 97 of the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act*, 1979 (NSW) gives you the right to appeal to the Land & Environment Court NSW within 6 months after the date on which you receive this notice.

Conditions of Consent

Approved plans

 All works must be carried out in accordance with this permit, the details set out on the application form, supporting information received with the application and the schedule of plans and details below except as amended by the conditions of this permit.

Copy of Permit to be available & produced

 A copy of this Permit must be available for inspection by an officer of the Council during the carrying out of the work covered by the Permit.

Amenity

3. The carrying out of the work covered by this Permit must not adversely affect the neighbouring properties or the environment and must take care to prevent excessive noise and the emission or discharge of chemicals, fumes, vapour, steam, dust, wastewater, waste products, grit, oil or other harmful products.

Noise pollution

4. The carrying out of the work covered by this Permit that requires the use of any tools (including hand tools) or any power operated plan or machinery that creates noise on or adjacent to the property MUST NOT BE CARRIED OUT or permitted to be carried out, except between the hours of 7:00am and 5:00pm Monday to Saturday inclusive other than Public Holidays.

Removal of trees where approved

5. All trees approved for removal by Council must be removed in a manner so as to prevent damage to those trees that are to be retained.

Pruning of trees where approved

- All works involved with the pruning of trees must be undertaken by a qualified arborist minimum AQF level 3 and must ensure that the works carried out are not detrimental to the survival of the tree.
- 7. All approved work is to be carried out in accordance with Australian standard AS4373-2007 Pruning of amenity trees
- Any pruning near electricity wires must be undertaken in accordance with relevant Electrical Safety Rules and be performed by persons authorised by the relevant Energy Supply Authority.

Replacement trees

For each tree removed, two canopy trees must be planted as replacement.
This must be completed within 3 months of removal and maintained for the life of the development.
